FOOTNOTES FOR 2013 JEANNE CLERY ACT STATISTICS REPORT

* Note: On Campus-Residential Facilities is a subset of Total on Campus Crimes.

The Jeanne Clery Act requires the disclosure of persons referred for campus disciplinary action and for liquor, drug, and weapons law violations. If both an arrest and a referral were made, only the arrest statistic is counted. Statistics for Campus Disciplinary Referrals reflect those students who were not arrested, but referred to the Office of Student Conduct & Conflict Resolution for disciplinary action.

Hate Crime Information: There were no reported Hate Crimes for the years 2011, 2012, or 2013. These crimes include crimes against persons involving criminal homicide, sex offenses, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, motor vehicle theft, arson, theft, simple assault, intimidation, or vandalism and any other crime involving bodily injury that manifest evidence that the victim was intentionally selected because of the victim's actual or perceived Race (RA), Religion (RE), Sexual Orientation (SO), Gender (G), Ethnicity (E), or Disability (D).
