


# PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, Dr. Livingston Alexander was named the third president of the University of Pittsburgh Bradford on April 24, 2003; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander guided the development of 16 academic majors, thereby increasing enrollment and retention; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander completed capital campaigns totaling \$33 million and increased the university's endowment and foundation assets by more than 250 percent; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander led efforts in the construction of five new residence halls and nondenominational chapel, significant renovations of two academic buildings, and upgrades to athletic facilities; and
- WHEREAS, Pitt-Bradford rose in national visibility, notably among the 10 best regional campuses by the website TheBestColleges, named among the best colleges in the northeast 14 consecutive times by The Princeton Review; and as one of the best regional colleges in the North by U.S. News & World Report;
- WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander also assumed the presidency of the University of Pittsburgh Titusville on May 7, 2012; and
- WHEREAS, Dr. Alexander's leadership at Pitt-Titusville was instrumental in the campus' progress in retention and graduation rate; and
- THEREFORE, on this date, June 15, 2018, the University of Pittsburgh Johnstown congratulates Dr. Livingston Alexander and the University of Pittsburgh Bradford on the dedication of the Livingston Alexander House.
